ROTARY CLUB OF CINCINNATI APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications may be faxed, emailed or mailed, as per the instructions below:

- 1. Complete the application and provide information as requested. Please attach your resume and/or biography and email us an electronic photograph at office@cincinnatirotary.org with your application.
- 2. Send your completed application, along with check or credit card information [made payable to The Rotary Club of Cincinnati] to 441 Vine Street, Suite 4192, Cincinnati, OH 45202. If paying by credit card, you may fill out the section included on this form. The application may also be returned by your sponsor(s) or given to the Executive Director at a club meeting. For security reasons, if submitting your application via email, please do not include credit card information. Call the Rotary office and we will add this information to your application.
- 3. After your application is received you will receive an e-mail confirmation from our office. You will be interviewed by our Classification Committee and your application will be submitted to The Board of Directors for review and approval. Once the Board has approved your membership, you will be listed to the Club for 5 days. After the 5 day waiting period, should no objections arise, you will be considered approved for membership. Should your membership be approved, you will be notified promptly.
