Legacy Circle Donation Opportunities

- **General Fund** - The General Fund donations provide funding for benefited charities and organizations.
- **Local Projects Fund** - The Local Projects Fund donations support the Rotary Foundation of Cincinnati's local projects, joint projects with local non-profits, and additional funding for local grants.
- **Fisk-Denman Fund** - The Fisk-Denman Fund donations are restricted to providing support for Tristate non-profits supporting children and adults with disabilities.
- **World Affairs Fund** - The World Affairs Fund donations are used for the Club's international projects.
- **World Affairs Endowment Fund** - The World Affairs Endowment Fund donations are invested permanently; annual spending policy (5% of principal) provides support to World Affairs projects.
- **Ira Abrahamson Vision Screening Fund** - The Ira Abrahamson Vision Screening Fund donations supports children's vision screening programs.
